Attendance

As you may be aware, the Department for Education are continuing to raise expectations for pupils to be in school as much as possible. School attendance has nationally seen a sharp decline since the pandemic and they are expecting all schools to work hard to support families to ensure their children have good school attendance.

We have seen a high number of families requesting time off for holidays this term and have had to refer some of these cases to the local authority for Fixed Penalty Notices for persistent absence. We appreciate that holidays are much cheaper in term time but when attendance is below 96%, we are expected by the DFE to act accordingly.

Staff are obliged to follow the expectations of the Department for Education in ensuring that children are in school as much as possible. We will continue to work with you to ensure your child's attendance is a high as it can be but will continue to issue Fixed Penalty Notices in September and beyond when required.

Illnesses will always count as authorised absence, but will accumulate the total absence overall.

School Uniform

This is a reminder of the uniform policy for your information. Please ensure that if your child is returning to Westgate in September, they have the following uniform.

Normal Days

Royal Blue Jumper – Logo preferred but not compulsory White polo shirt, shirt, blouse, Navy blue trousers, skirts / pinafores (Grey or black hand-me-downs will be okay) Black shoes or plain black trainers, velcro / buckle preferred – non-explicitly branded

PE Days – Arrive in PE clothes as this saves time which means more time doing the lesson. School hoodie / school jumper White t-shirt Plain leggings or tracksuit bottoms in winter or navy or royal blue shorts during warmer weather Trainers (not pumps)
