Children in both KS1 and KS2 have been using assemblies to discuss bullying this week. We have discussed the meaning of bullying, what could be seen as 'bullying' behaviour and what to do if they or someone they know were being bullied. We have sent out a letter to parents this week regarding this area as this was something that was requested through our parent survey earlier this year.

At Westgate, we define bullying as:

• Targeted, intended to hurt someone either physically or emotionally and repeated (Several Times On Purpose – STOP).

A Reminder:

We have had a number of occasions recently where children have arrived unaccompanied on the school grounds at very early times. We have our 'Meet and Greet' system in school from 8.30am in KS1 and 8.40am in KS2 to enable children to arrive a little earlier and settle in to class.



However, the playground and school grounds are not supervised before this time. For safety reasons, please ensure your child arrives at school at the correct time. Many thanks.


